Good afternoon everybody. Here's my report for July, 2018. Last month I gave my report, but forgot to hand it in. If you need to see my report from last month, I have it here with me. I also have some more final drafts of the CAR report if you didn't get one last month. Last month I was asked about our groups insurance policy. Paying for our insurance is not mandatory. It is a suggestion that we donate \$15.00 per year. Our total insurance cost for the year is \$585.00 dollars for the whole region. All home groups are entitled to a copy of the insurance policy. If your group wants one you will need to contact John@fpzinc.com. John is our insurance liaison.

At our previous regional meeting there was a problem with our previous secretary. She had possession of some of our archives and receipts for \$400 dollars spent. I didn't put it in my last report because we were allowing our vice chair to get in contact with her. Our vice chair made contact and we got the archives, but no accountability of the money. They are going to get in contact with her and see if they can get her to sign a promissory note for the \$400 dollars. The web chair is going to scan those archives and we'll store the paper copies elsewhere.

The MARLCNA committee turned in \$22,748.69 to the region from the conference/convention. They believe that they could keep better track of the money if they had a book-keeper. So they've created a new position called Book Keeper. Witch is well within the committees rights. MARLCNA sub-committee guidelines were also passed. No one came up with any new ideas for distributing PPP's, so if you have any ideas let me know and I'll try to get them to the committee.

If you read the CAR final report then you should know that zones are now part of our service structure. N.A. as a whole is now looking for the best way to utilize them. This will be ongoing for a while. I'll do my best to keep you posted. One of the questions from our RD is do we need a new position (NEZF Liaison) to be a means of communication between our region and the zones. An adhoc committee has been formed to look into this. The chair is our previous RD Kathleen and Pam is our vice chair. I also volunteered to be part of the committee. They are supposed to notify me when they have their next virtual meeting.
