**POLICY:** David apologizes for not being able to attend Area Service today. He has some personal issues he is attending to. Good progress is being made on Policy and a draft should be available for next Area. Thanks for allowing me to serve. Steve H.

**PUBLIC RELATIONS:** We recorded the phone line meetings on July 7, 2014. I'm asking the groups to please look on the meeting list to make sure the info for their group is correct, please. We also have new fliers for public relations, I'm asking that all home group GSR please take them back to your home group and read them during NA announcements! Talked to Deanna Johnson on July 7, 2014. As of October 1, 2013 phone power is under Stericycle Communications. In June Stericycle went through all of their customer's accounts and looked to see when was their last increase and our last increase was 18 months ago, so they decided to increase our bill 4% , so that's why there is an increase in the bill. When we dial the number and they recording comes on we are being charged. We also get charged when someone answers our calls. We also get charged when they are going down the phone list. We get charged for inbound and outbound calls. Our plan is \$130.00 for 115 minutes a month. When we go over 115 minutes we get charged \$1.00 per minute. Our July 1<sup>st</sup> bill is for the month of June we used 125 minutes which is 10 minutes over and we are being charged \$10.00 extra. We are not locked into the plan we have. Our average usage a year is 116 minutes per month. See email, below...

Hi Glenda,

Thank you very much for taking the time to speak with us regarding your account. We appreciate your feedback and want to make sure we are meeting your expectations.

As requested, I have outlined below your billing rate plan as well as the usage history for your account. Currently, you are on a monthly base rate of \$125.00 for 115 minutes. Usage would consist of all operator time on inbound and outbound calls. That will include taking down the message information and the time spent in delivering the message.

Your average usage for the year is 117 minutes which is close to your month rate plan. Your usage varies from a low of 66 minutes, to a high of 168 minutes. It does appear that 7 out of 12 months, you have exceeded the 125 minute call plan. I have outlined a couple other rate plans that will offer you additional minutes at a lower per minute cost. This would also help you decrease the amount of overages billed and the fluctuations in the invoice amounts. Your average invoice amount for the year is \$180.00

and ranged from \$125-\$225.

The next rate plan available is :

1. \$155 for 150 minutes. Overages would be billed at \$0.98 per minute.
2. \$170 for 175 minutes. Overages would be billed at \$0.95 per minute.

Please review and let me know if you would like to upgrade to any of these plans. Your account will go to billing early next week, so If you could let me know by Monday, June 2, 2014 that would be great.
