Everything matches so far except the motion regarding quorum from 12/11/1994. Policy log reads that the quorum is “one more than 1/3. In a mass meeting, the quorum is simply the number of persons present at the time.” However, sometime in the last 5-6 years it got changed to “Quorum is defined as one more than 1/3.” We will be going back to 2019 and reviewing all previous area minutes to ensure that motions from 2019-2024 have been recorded in policy log. -Candice M, Policy Chair
